

EastBio Website Launch – Information about website access and editing rights

For EASTBIO students and supervisors only

The redesigned EASTBIO website is now online. EASTBIO students and supervisors are the website's 'authenticated users' (=Drupal terminology for users who can post comments, write on the Forum, write blogs, etc.).

Important information on access and editing rights found below.

- **To browse the website:** <http://www.eastscotbiodtp.ac.uk/>
- **To access restricted areas of the website** (e.g. resources, PIPS forms, forum, under the Research page) **and/or edit content** (write on the forum or post a comment):
 - **When you are on the University of Edinburgh network:**
 - Go to http://sbsweb2.bio.ed.ac.uk/eastbio_dev/user
 - Select: **Request New Password**, enter email address.
 - When email is received, go to http://sbsweb2.bio.ed.ac.uk/eastbio_dev/user to *reset your personal Drupal account password*. Once you are logged in via this account, you'll be able to access restricted pages, write on the Forum, etc. *Make sure you use your university email address as that was the one used to set up your personal account.*
 - **When you are *not* on the University of Edinburgh network:**
 - If you don't have an Edinburgh Ease login, create your **EASE Friend** account here: <https://www.ease.ed.ac.uk/friend/>
 - Go to https://sbsweb2.bio.ed.ac.uk/eastbio_dev/user (first access for your current session requires Ease Friend login)
 - Go to https://sbsweb2.bio.ed.ac.uk/eastbio_dev/user to *reset your personal Drupal account password*. Once you are logged in via this account, you'll be able to access restricted pages, write on the Forum, etc. *Make sure you use your university email address as that was the one used to set up your personal account.*
 - Select: **Request New Password**, enter email address.
 - **For both Edinburgh & non-Edinburgh:**

After you have reset your Drupal password, you will have access to the restricted pages and be able to write on the Forum, etc.

Please note that EASTBIO students' profiles via PURE will be uploaded on the website once inter-partner Agreements are in place. Please note: you can *only* login the website via the sbsweb2.bio.ed.ac.uk/eastbio_dev/user.
