Presentation format

You are asked to present your project in the PechaKucha 20x20 format (<http://www.pechakucha.org/faq/>). You will select a total of 20 images from your research and speak along to these for 20' per image: a total of 7 minutes, plus 5' for Q&A. You should aim to present your project as a story that would make sense to non-experts but also be prepared for questions from experts too. The best talk will receive a prize at the close of the Symposium.

Abstracts

Please send EASTBIO an abstract of your presentation to form part of the symposium pack. The abstract should state:

- * Title of your project
- * Your name and the name/s of your supervisor/s
- * Your affiliation
- * Abstract of 250 words max.

You should submit your abstract **no later than the first week of August**.
